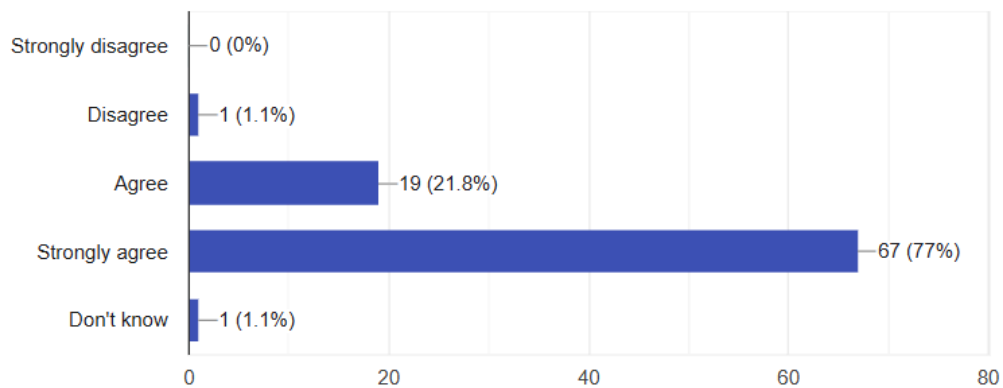

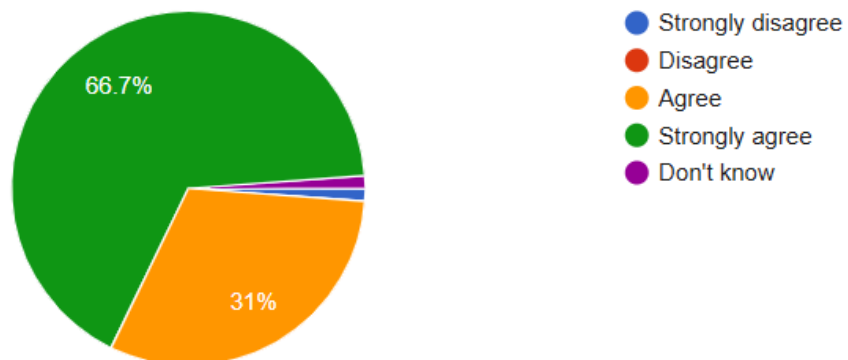
87 responses

My child feels/ children feel safe at this school.

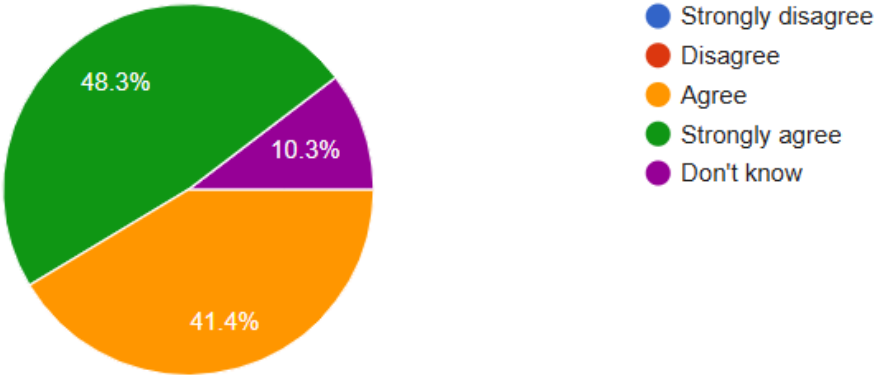
87 responses

The school makes sure its pupils are well behaved.

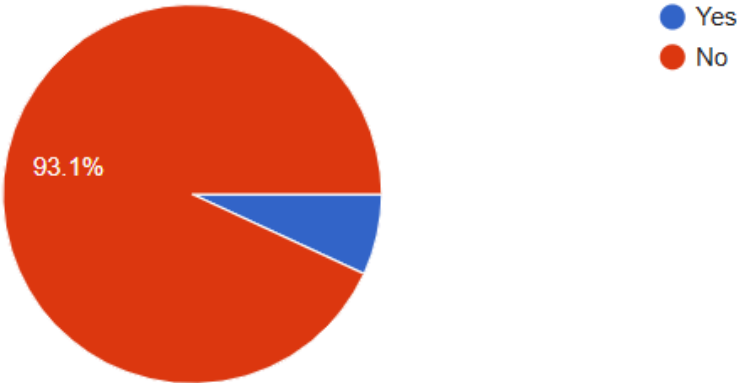
87 responses

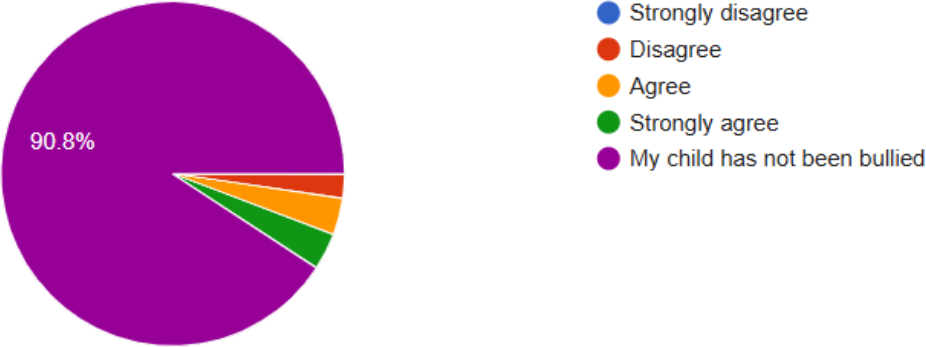


**6.9% reported that their child had been bullied.**

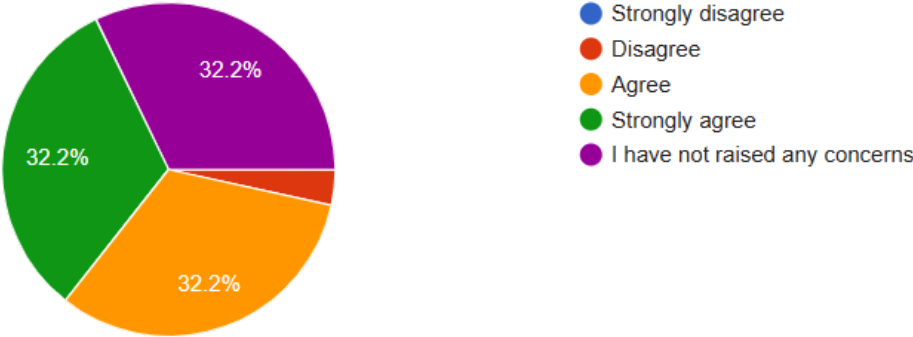


***Of the 8 families that reported incidents of bullying 6 strongly agreed or agreed that it was dealt with quickly and effectively.***

When I have raised concerns with the school they have been dealt with properly.



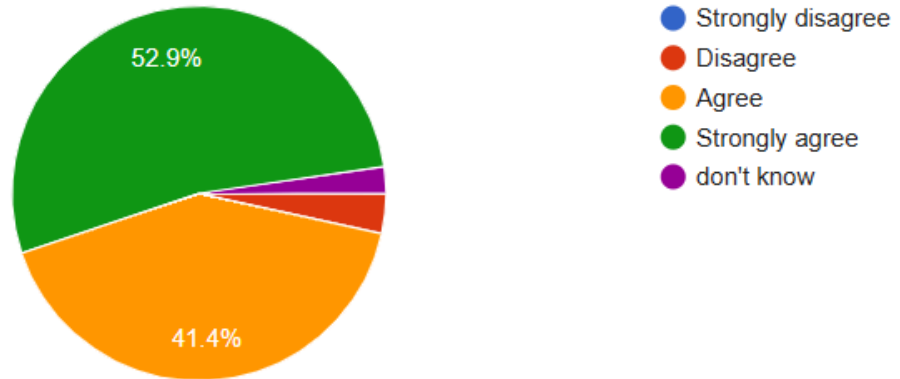

The school communicates well with me about the things I need to know.

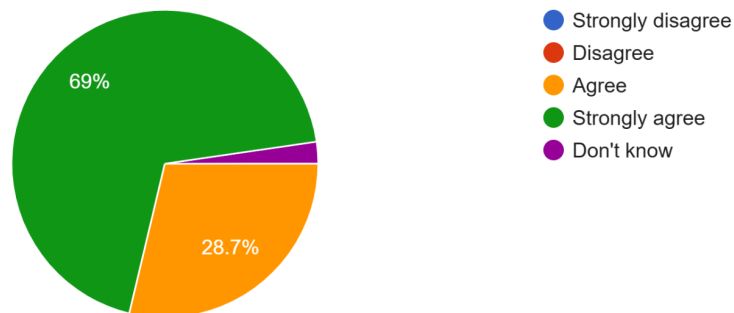

**94.3% of families strongly agreed or agreed that the school communicates well the things they need to know.**

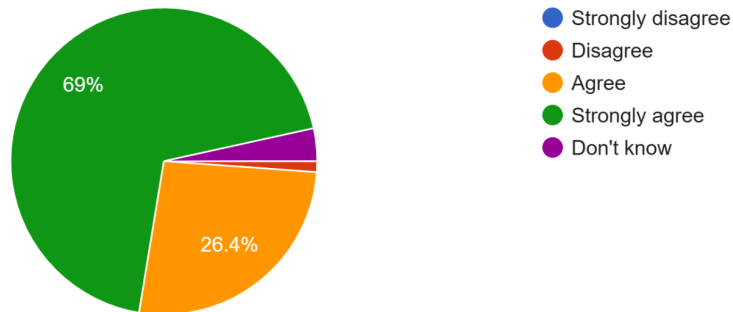
When the school makes decisions, it has the child's best interests at heart.

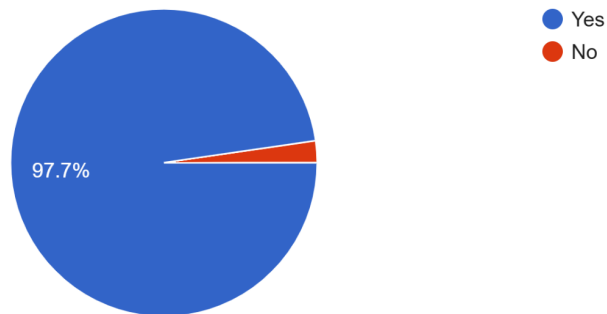
**97.7% of families agree that when the school makes decisions, it has the child's best interests at heart.**

<i>Maybe a slightly earlier heads up for parents whose children are receiving Monday morning certificates.</i>	Certificates are awarded on Fridays in recognition of the children's achievements throughout the week. If you are unable to attend, we can arrange for the presentation to take place the following week instead.	Ensure staff are clear that certificates can be postponed to support families attending.
<i>I feel that the communication could be better at times and to also give a little more notice for things.</i>	I understand your concern about communication and the need for more notice. We are always looking to improve in this area. If there are specific examples, please do share them so we can address them directly.	Raise this with the senior leadership team and Governors so we can review our processes.
<i>We think there should be a no tolerance policy for play fighting in the playground because some children don't understand the limits of that kind of play.</i>	We do have a no play fighting policy in place and this is actively monitored by staff on the playground, who will intervene where necessary to ensure all children remain safe and play appropriately.	Continue to remind both staff and children of the 'no play fighting' policy. This is essential to ensure a safe, respectful, and well-supervised environment at all times. Consistent reinforcement of this expectation will help maintain clear boundaries and reduce the risk of accidents or misunderstandings during play.
