Dear Parents / Carers,

Welcome back to a new term, a new term that currently is very different to what we would normally be expecting. I hope you had a lovely Easter break and managed to enjoy some of the beautiful sunshine that we have had.

We've all had to adapt to new ways of working, so I wanted to take the opportunity to say what an amazing job you're doing supporting your child's wellbeing and learning during this time.

It's definitely been a strange and challenging time, so it's ok if you and your child feel wobbly and worried at the moment. We're here for you every step of the way as we figure this all out together. Remember, if you have any concerns about helping your child learn or you need any other support from the school, please let us know by contacting teachers through class dojo.

As you are aware the teachers are still coming into school to support and look after children who are vulnerable and children of workers critical to the COVID19 response (Key Workers). If your child meets this criteria and is coming into school for part of the week, on the days that they are at home with you they only need to complete some of the home learning activities posted on Class Dojo by the teachers. We will not be expecting you to complete five days of home learning in your two or three days of being at home with your child, that would be very unrealistic.

Please see below the rota for the next two weeks, for the days teachers are in school. This may occasionally change due to Staff family circumstances or illness. On the days that teachers are in school, unfortunately they will not be able to respond to any questions regarding home learning that day. The days the teachers are not in school and that would be their normal working days, they will be working from home.
